The degree in Property is designed to equip graduates with the knowledge to succeed in the all main areas of property including valuation, agency, management, development, investment and research. The program is delivered at the City West Campus of the University in the Adelaide central business district.

Candidates will be required to conduct research, independently and as a member of a team, which will result in publications in international academic refereed journals; attract and supervise postgraduate research students; enhance the research profile of the School through collaborative research with other Universities and organisations and through involvement in relevant professional activities; source and develop research proposals and funding submissions to industry and external funding bodies; promote a culture of scholarship and excellence in research and teaching and learning, through working collaboratively with staff in the School, and the University; actively contribute to the School and Division's activities, particularly in relation to planning and administration; create, foster and enhance national and international links with relevant industry, business and community bodies that assist in the advancement of University, Division and School objectives; participate in industry funded research programs or related professional development on behalf of the School, as required.

Applicants should have a PhD in a relevant field; an established and substantial research profile demonstrated by refereed publications, competitive research grants, and evidence of successful supervision of doctoral students, among several other requirements
