The Department of Economics, Finance, and Legal Studies invites applications for a full-time, non-tenure track faculty position at the rank of instructor to teach real estate courses. The appointment is expected to begin August 15, 2010. The successful candidate may teach up to four courses per semester and will work in conjunction with current real estate faculty for advancement of the program and its curriculum. Candidates with either an academic or professional real estate background are welcome to apply. For academic applicants, publications in academic or practitioner journals are necessary as evidence of scholarship. Real estate practitioner applicants should be active in their field, have at least five years of professional real estate experience, and regularly attend professional conferences. Prior teaching experience is a plus. Graduate work in real estate as indicated by an advanced degree is desirable.

This is a non-tenure earning position renewable for three-year periods at the discretion of the University with no expectation of continued employment beyond any three-year contract period. Candidates selected for interview will be required to submit a disclosure and consent form authorizing a background investigation. Only online applications are accepted. Candidates must apply online at <https://facultyjobs.ua.edu> and attach a curriculum vita that includes three references, documentation of teaching effectiveness, and evidence of scholarship. Items not attached at time of application will disqualify application. Review of applicants will continue until the position is filled. Members of the search committee will be attending the 2010 American Real Estate Society meeting in Naples, Florida.
