



## Curriculum Vitae (CV)

A curriculum vitae, usually referred to as CV, is a life statement of your professional career that is often used when applying for teaching positions or in academic settings. A CV is usually longer than two or more pages. It includes a much more detailed synopsis of your professional experiences than a résumé. Typical sections of a CV are as follows:

Contact information

Education

Summary of your academic background

Summary of your teaching experience

Summary of your research experience

Publications (you can separate refereed and now refereed publications).

Presentations

Awards & honors

Affiliations

Positions on committees, boards, and other details
